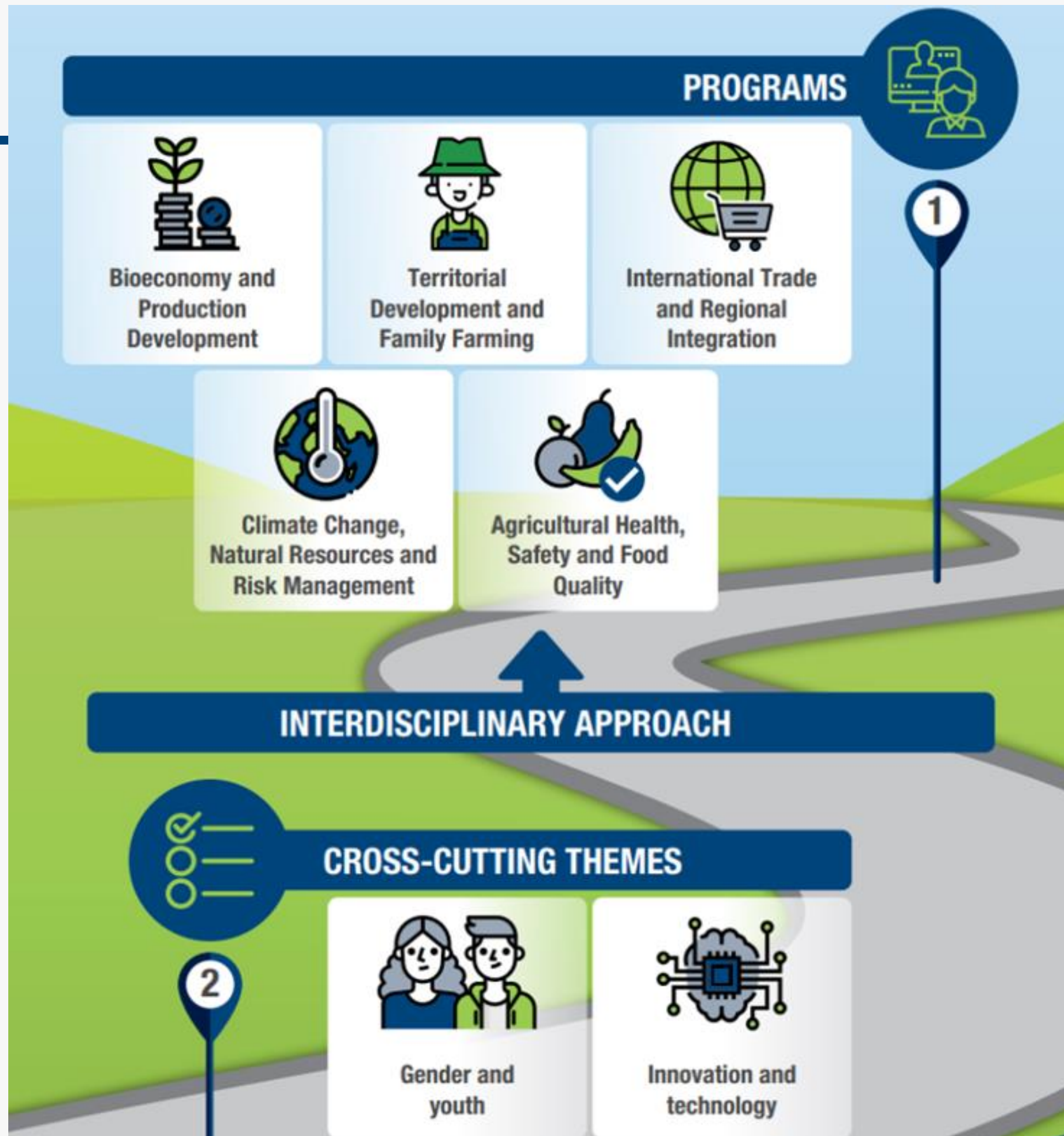

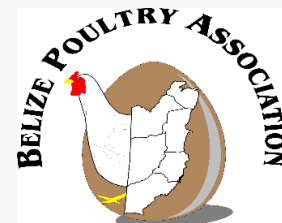


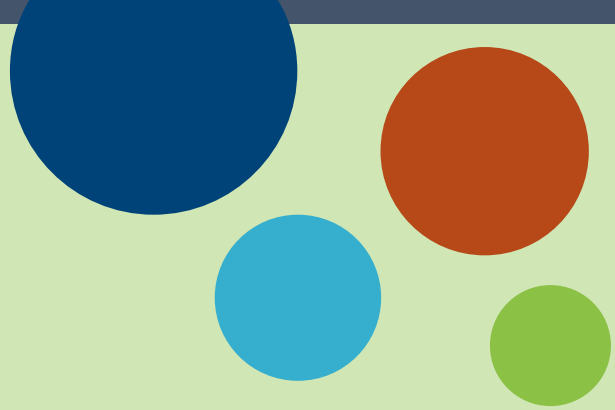

A BIOSECURITY SYSTEM FOR BACKYARD CHICKENS

BIOSECURITY: ...the things we do at our farm to prevent disease from entering or spreading.



Bury dead chickens with white lime before covering with earth.



Use clean footwear dedicated for the chicken area.



Restrict access for people and vehicles.



Secure fence.
Chickens, feed and clean water.



Keep different types of poultry separate.



Keep records important events (e.g. debeaking, vaccination, deworming).



Vaccinate your flocks against diseases like Newcastle Disease.



Quarantine new chickens at a separate location.



Put up a biosecurity sign



Remove sick chickens and keep separate from main flock



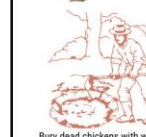
