





Establishing the non-intrusive Quarantine inspection

October 2021 it was agreed to implement the non-intrusive quarantine inspection service with the use of X-Rays

- 1. Ministry of Tourism to cover cost of operation for the first 3 months
- 2. OIRSA hires personnel
- 3. Training in Comayagua, Honduras
- 4. January 2022, the non-intrusive quarantine inspections starts.















Trial for the control of corn ear worm, Spodoptera





Biological control of *Diatraea* saccharialis on sugar cane plantations with SIRDI.












Results of biological control of *Diatraea* saccharialis on sugar cane plantations with SIRDI.
